Sir,

Further to our letter of the 27th June 1951, and your letter of the 14th July last, regarding the classification of tankers built or building at Cammell Laird & Co., we have the pleasure to inform you, that at a further interview today at the offices of Yacimientos Petroliferos Fiscales, we were informed of their decision to retain the classification of the following additional vessels built or being built as follows:-

"Islas Malvinas", "Islas Orcadas", "Islas Georgias", "Director Madariaga", "La Plata", "San Lorenzo", and "Rodrigo Rivadavia".

It is also the Owners intention to reclass the M.T. "San Jose", and we shall be advised in due course of the date the vessel is being drydocked, so that the Special Survey can be carried out with a view to reclassification.

A translation of the letter which was handed to us by Y.P.F. confirming above, is enclosed herewith.
