With reference to your letter regarding this ship, I have to advise you that she has been sold by the Nova Scotian Government to Captain Raymond Duval, who intends to change the machinery from steam to diesel and carry out alterations to hatches, etc.

I have met Captain Duval, but have been unable to obtain from him a statement regarding the future Classification of the ship, but as alterations are now in hand, it is unlikely that he will request the ship to remain classed with Lloyd's Register or any other Society.

Captain Duval's address is: 532 Bardy Street, Quebec City, P.Q., and I am informed that the Port of Registry of the ship will be changed to Halifax, N. S.

I will keep you informed when I receive some accurate information regarding the machinery, tonnages and other particulars of this ship.
