R.F.A. SAUCY

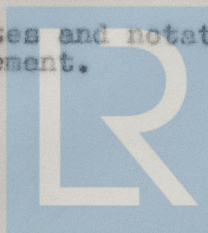

Survey dates as given in the Register Book Supplement. It will be noted that the drydocking survey, Boiler Survey, Screwshaft Survey and Steam Pipe Survey are overdue. The vessel has been laid up at Pembroke Dock and attention is drawn to my letter addressed to the Admiralty on the 17th October last, a copy of which was forwarded to you.

R.F.A. UPLIFTER

Survey dates and notation as given in Register Book Supplement. A Special Survey was carried out by the London Surveyors in April/July 1959, but assignment of the notation SS 7.59 was deferred pending an outstanding matter of equipment being dealt with and the Engine Survey completed. When she was under survey in London in July, 1959 there appeared to be some doubt regarding the equipment then on board. A Boiler Survey was partly held on that occasion, but a further complete Boiler Survey again became due at the end of July, 1960. It is concluded the vessel is still laid up at Pembroke Dock, but I shall be glad if you will confirm that this is so.

R.F.A. JAUNTY.

Survey dates as given in the Register Book Supplement. A Special Survey was carried out by the London Surveyors in June/November, 1959, but assignment of the notation SS 11.59 has been deferred pending completion of the Engine Survey. A Boiler Survey was also partly held on that occasion, but a further complete Boiler Survey again became due at the end of November, 1960. It is concluded the vessel is still laid up in your district, but your confirmation will be appreciated.
