EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR SPECIAL SURVEY (Vessel 18 years old).

REPAIRS (WEAR & TEAR):- The following shell plates renewed -

Starbd. Side. F. strake, 2,3,4,5,6,7 & 8 with an inserted 'D' patch in H.3, and J.3 removed, faired and refitted.

Port Side. E.6 and aft end of E.5 (about 3 ft.) renewed in one plate.
J.2(aft 5ft.) J.3 & J.4 renewed. Aft 3ft of H.2 cropped and renewed.

Several local indents P&S. (mainly in E.strake) faired in place.

Approx. 1000 odd rivets renewed throughout vessel. Approx. 150ft. of wood belting and angles renewed, including wooden bow fender.

Boat deck, or casing top, on starbd. side, 2 plates alongside deckhouse renewed and the inboard 15" of the stringer plate cropped and renewed from bridge aft (4 plates). On Port side 2 plates alongside deckhouse renewed. All wood sheathing renewed in way of these repairs.
