Dear Sir,

"HIKAWA MARU" and "ARIMASAN MARU"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo, and give below the fees which would be charged in ships of this size and age if reclassification surveys were carried out in the United Kingdom.

The fees to be charged in Japan will, naturally, require to be adjusted to conform to the current practice in Japan.

If more than the considered normal amount of survey repairs, etc., have to be effected, and the number of visits increases thereby, the fees should be increased in proportion to the services rendered.
