I have to acquaint you that a Representative of the Owners has called at this Office, and states with regard to the examination you have made of the hull of the vessel that it is desired that a special survey and examination of the machinery may also be carried out with a view to the issue of a certificate to the effect that it is in good working condition, and in accordance with the Society's Rules.

In the circumstances, you are authorised to hold a survey on the engines and boilers, and for your information and guidance in the matter I enclose a copy of a certificate dated 24th December, 1924, which was issued on form 10 by the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam in regard to their survey of the machinery during construction. Kindly return the enclosure with your report, and the certificate which you propose to issue in the case (accompanied by a carbon copy for filing).

I also send the First Entry Report (Rot. 12984) on the machinery, which should be returned in due course.
