With reference to your letter of the 5th February last regarding the Third Special Survey No.1 of the steamer "ISONOMIA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them today a report from the Society's Surveyor at Kingston, Jamaica, from which it appears that the vessel put into that port on account of shortage of fuel, while on a voyage to the United Kingdom, and some minor repairs were effected.

The vessel is reported to have left Kingston on the 21st ultimo for the Azores for orders, and in the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will let me know what definite arrangements have been made with a view to the requirements of the Special Survey being complied with .
