Dear Mr. Keith,

I was favoured with your letter of yesterday's date, from which I note that Mr. Prentice desires to be afforded any information in the possession of this Office regarding the steamer "ISONOMIA". From the enclosed cutting from Lloyd's List, it would appear that the vessel arrived at Panama on the 25th January, and I may say for Mr. Prentice's information that on the occasion of the survey held at San Francisco early in December last the Surveyor recommended that the Third Special Survey No. 1, which became due during that month, should be held after the cargo she then had on board had been discharged, as the vessel showed considerable deterioration.

The Owners were informed accordingly, and in a letter received at this Office yesterday they stated that the matters in question would have their attention "upon the vessel's arrival on the other side". We do not know whether from this they intend sending the vessel to this Country for survey or to the Eastern Coast of the United States.
