Mr. Prentice, who is the Manager of the Sea Insurance Co., and a Member of the Liverpool Committee is very much concerned about the very protracted voyage of the steamer "ISONOMIA".

It appears that the vessel left Panama Canal on the 5th December and only arrived at Kingston, Jamaica, on the 18th February and as she is on a voyage from Vancouver to the United Kingdom the extraordinary delay seems unaccountable.

Mr. Prentice observes that the vessel is classed in the Society's Register Book and she would appear to have been examined in dock and had Boiler and Screwshaft surveys in 12-26.

I wonder if by any chance you have any information in your possession which would account for the delay.
