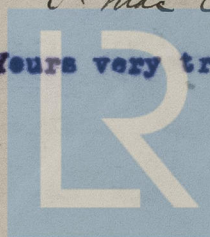
Dear Sir;-

Yours of September 16th-1919 with certificates of classification for S.S. "Canadian Sailer" hull No. 40 Port Arthur Shipbuilding Co. received and may say bulkhead stiffeners are as approved and spaced as required.

The rivets in the butts of poop, bridge and forecastle are spaced $3\frac{1}{2}$ diameters as required.

Upper weather decks have been tested as rules require and dry tank under boiler tested as required.
