Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that the Tanksteamer "DAVID C. REID" ex "SILVERBROOK" arrived at this port last week and requested a certificate for cleanness of circular tanks to carry molasses in bulk.

After some additional cleaning I granted the certificate of cleanness but pointed out to shippers and master the fact that the vessel's character was expunged in April 1927. The master informed me that the probable cause had been a discrepancy in the length of the chaincables, but that the vessel had been recently reinstated in her original class and also classed with the American Bureau.

As there may have been another reason and the vessel may return to this port for further cargoes I should be glad to be further advised regarding this case.
