the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Rankin & Blackmore, Ltd., Engineers, Greenock, attend their works between the 27th July and 19th August 1949, for the purpose of examining during manufacture and on completion, the renewal of all Journals and Pins of the Crank Shaft of the Steam Trawler:-

"KELVINCOURT" (

276 tons gross of Aberdeen - No. 15123 in the Register Book.
Manufacturer's Job No. 49/199.

The material for the Journals and Crank Pins has been made from Siemens Martin Ingot Steel by the Fife Forge Co., Ltd, of Kircaldy as per Leith Forging Certificate No. F.5438.

After removal of the old Journals and Pins, the crank webs were lightly rebored to ensure alignment, the shrinking of the new Journals and pins was carried out in a satisfactory manner and thereafter new dowel pins fitted to slightly larger diameter than those originally fitted.

On completion of the assembly the Crankshaft was machined in the lathe to finished dimensions as per Manufacturer's Blue Print, the eccentric keyways cut and coupling bolt holes bored. The workmanship throughout is good.

For purposes of identification, the after coupling of the crank shaft has been marked :) L.R. 3438. O.J.T. 19/8/49. JB
