Assignment of class has been deferred until the reports of inspections in drydock at Dungun have been received, and in this respect I refer to your letter of the 13th November last and now await your further information.

"INCHISTUART." Reverting to my classing letter of the 14th March, I shall be glad to learn whether the Owners have yet made arrangements for the main engine crankpins to be examined.

15487. "PATROCLUS." As recommended, except that this ship will be entitled to a notation of Engine Survey on completion.

15498. "ELI MAFRSK." As recommended, except that having regard to the contents of your letter and enclosure of the 7th instant the notation of ABS (aft) 3.62 has also been assigned at this time.

15501. "BENHIANT." As recommended, except that a notation of SGS 2.62 has been assigned at this time.

15514. "BATU MAS." As recommended, postponement of the Special Survey until March, 1963 having been approved. Please inform the Owners accordingly.

15518. "SRI TRENGGANU." As recommended. I shall be glad however, to learn when the Owners intend to deal with the excessive fore and aft movement of both tailshafts.
