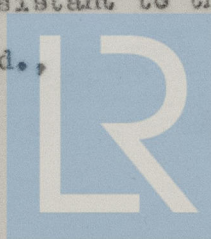
I shall be glad to be favoured with a remittance in settlement at your convenience.
