Whenever the placement of Anchors or Chains is reported, the particulars should be clearly stated in the space provided on the back of this form. State also the dates and initials of any letters respecting this case.

Damage cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he required to state whether he Society's Freeboard (if assigned) as painted on Ship and now verified. Was a damage report made by anyone else? If so, by whom?
