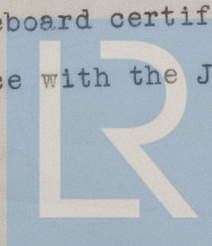

Dear Sir,

Reverting to previous correspondence regarding the verification of the freeboard marks of the above vessel in connection with the issue of fresh certificates, I have to inform you that she has recently been under survey in this district, and the freeboard markings have been verified. I find however, that when this vessel was imported into Japan in 1926 fresh freeboards were assigned by the Society in accordance with the Load Line Law of Japan, and the vessel's original freeboard certificates were returned to you, for cancellation, with my letter of the 3rd August 1926.

A fresh freeboard certificate has therefore, been issued in accordance with the Japanese Government

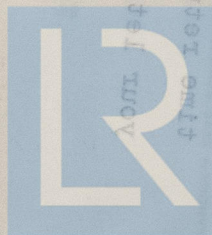
