Referring to your communication of the 24th October last, in which you advised us that the Special Survey and Annual Classification Survey of the above named vessel falls due in December/49, we would be obliged to learn if the Classification Committee would be good enough to grant us six months extension from this date, owing to the vessel being on Time Charter, as it would seriously inconvenience us should the vessel have to be withdrawn at the present moment.
