7255 tons gross of Palermo, whilst lying afloat at the plant of the Bethlehem Steel Co., Lower Yard, Baltimore, Maryland, the 19th of February, 1961, for the purpose of witnessing a lifting test of following cargo derricks.

No. 1 hatchway two 5 ton derricks tested to 6.25 tons.

No. 2 hatchway two 5 ton derricks tested to 6.25 tons.

No. 3 hatchway two 5 ton derricks tested to 6.25 tons.

No. 4 hatchway two 5 ton derricks tested to 6.25 tons.

No. 5 hatchway two 5 ton derricks tested to 6.25 tons.

By means of wire rope and a spring balance and with the cargo derricks at angle of 45°, a load being 25% in excess of the safe working load was applied to the 5 ton derricks.

The above mentioned test was carried out to my satisfaction as regards the stresses imposed by the test load mentioned.
