Dear Sirs,

We have recently purchased from the Admiralty the Steam Drifters "Node" and "Blizzard" but as these Vessels have not been previously registered we cannot give you the Official numbers but the Vessels were built by Messrs. Colby Bros., Ltd of Gulton Broad, Lowestoft in 1919-20 and their Yard numbers were 91 and 92 respectively.

It is the intention of the Company to alter the names of these Vessels, and we have already got the permission from the Registrar General of Shipping & Seamen to name these Vessels the "Tiger's Eye" and "Satinstone". The "Node" which will be re-named the "Tiger's Eye" is at present in the St. Andrew's Dock Hull, but the "Blizzard" which will be named the "Satinstone" is at Brightlingsea undergoing repairs &c., and I shall be glad if you will let me have a letter signed by the Secretary of Lloyds Registry of Shipping that the Society's rules as regards Survey have been complied with.
