Dear Sirs,

Steamer "FERNANDO"

Reverting to your letter addressed to Lloyd's Agents at Barranquilla on 26th June last, I would remind you that a Special Survey fell due on the above named ship in June, 1960, and the Committee agreed to postponement of that inspection until some time before the end of September, 1961.

Since that date I have not been successful in obtaining any definite information in regard to this survey and doubtless Lloyd's Agents have been in touch with you on the subject.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee today and they have instructed me to inform you that unless a firm and satisfactory proposal for early compliance with the Society's Rules regarding Special Surveys is received by Friday next, 24th instant, the Committee will feel they have no alternative but to withdraw the ship's class owing to non-compliance with our Regulations.

This information has been cabled to you this afternoon and I hope you will be able to reply to this letter by the time stated.
