The Committee have had before them a report of the Special Survey which was held on this vessel by the Society's Newcastle Surveyors during November/March last, from which it is noted that the repairs previously effected to the LP cylinder were examined and found to remain efficient.

It is recommended, however, that these repairs should be again examined before the end of March next, and the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to this matter receiving attention by that time.

In the meantime they have assigned notations of S.S.Sh1.3.52, LMC MS 10.51, BS 3.52 and "Fitted for oil fuel 3.52" F.P. above 150° F", together with records of Docking and Screwshaft Examination 2.52.

Classification Certificates in respect of hull and machinery are enclosed herewith.
