The undersigned Surveyors to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Edward James (Newcastle) Limited, attend their Works at Team Valley Trading Estate, Gateshead-on-Tyne, on the 2nd January, 1952 and subsequent dates, for the purpose of examining one Diesel Generating Set ordered by Messrs. J. Christensen, Christensen & Smith Ltd. of Newcastle, and intended for the s.s. "BORGFRED".

The 3 cylinder Diesel Engine No. 60/14877 manufactured by Messrs. R.A. Lister Ltd. has a bore diameter of 4½" and 6" stroke, and is directly coupled to a Mawdsley C. Generator, Serial No. 100S2307 of 15 KW. 110 volts, 1500 r.p.m. running at 1100 R.P.M. compound wound, continuously tested.

The generator was examined and tested for insulation resistance and found to be satisfactory.

The engine was completely opened up for survey and all components examined and found to be in efficient working condition. New pistons and rings and a new bottom end bearing and one new top end bush were fitted at this time.

On completion of the survey the machine was run under full load conditions and the governor tested and found efficient and the general performance was considered satisfactory.
