With reference to your letter of the 17th February last regarding American built cargo ships N3-S-A1, we are to-day forwarding our reports (No. 34878) on the above vessel from which it will be observed that, so far as the hull is concerned, whilst a notation of Special Survey is recommended, a General Examination only has been held at this time.

A Special Survey was held by the British Corporation in June last.

In the circumstances, we shall be glad to learn what fee should be charged for the survey of the hull, machinery and electrical equipment.

A freeboard assignment survey has also been carried out.

This case is similar to the "WILLIAM BURSLEY", referred to in our letter of the 3rd instant.
