Steamer "ALFXANDROS"
"Surveys overdue 1.56"

Reverting to your memorandum of the 1st July last, I have to inform you that this case has been reviewed by the Committee.

It is noted that although the requirements of a Drilling Special Survey were partly complied with at your port in September, 1957/December, 1958, a second four-yearly Special Survey period has elapsed since the last date of survey recorded in the Register Book, and in these circumstances the Committee feel, in the absence of any proposal for dealing with the overdue surveys, that they would not be justified in continuing the class of this ship.

They have, therefore, given instructions for a record to be made in the Register Book indicating that the class has been withdrawn.
