("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

The Notation "Surveys Overdue 1,56" appears in the Register Book.

There is an S.R.L. Appendix Note.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 1,56. Postponement until 11,56 approved 27.1.56. General Examination held Feb. 11, 55. Further postponement until 7,57 approved 12.3.57 as the result of a Comprehensive General Examination held at Genoa and Piraeus January/February, 1957. Notation of "General Examination 2,57(5mos)" was assigned. Special Survey commenced Pir. 12,58 (principal portion).

TO COMPLETE THE S.S. the following items are outstanding:-

Anchors & cables to be ranged and gauged,
Chain locker to be examined,
Shell plating to be drilled in way of end cargo tanks in accordance with Chapter C, Para. 306 of the Rules,
All cargo tanks to be tested.

The PIRAEUS Surveyors report (2,60), ship examined afloat for ranging damage involving minor items.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the Notation of "Surveys Overdue 1,56" be retained in the Register Book.

The ship is still laid up at Perama, Greece.
