- (1) 6 Side Scuttles of substantial construction and fitted with hinged deadlights fitted in Bridge 'Tween Deck (P.S.)
- (2) 1 W.C. Discharge) From Bridge 'Tween Deck, each discharge fitted with
1 Wash Basin Discharge) N.R. Storm Valve on shell below Freeboard Deck.
- (3) Port Bunker Trimming Hatch on Bridge Deck converted into steel companionway, 6' 3" high x 3' 6" x 2' 10", door coaming 31" and steel door 3' 2" x 21" able to be manipulated from both sides.
