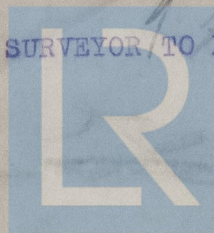
I regret that the above particulars were omitted from my report on the Hull of this vessel.
