Major repairs and alterations which may have taken place affecting the structure since the ship was disclassified to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and confirm that the scantlings and materials are in accordance with the Rules. 3. Examination of freeboard items and arrangements as noted on the existing C11 and any alterations to freeboard items that may have taken place. 4. Full particulars of equipment on board including weights tests and condition of anchors, also length, diameter, test and conditions etc. of chain cable to be furnished for consideration. 5. Arrangements for fire protection, detection and extinction, means of escape, communication etc, are to be examined in accordance with the Rules. 6. Any C.O.C.'s which may have been imposed by any other Classification Society to be dealt with as previously recommended.
