Steamer "DANAB"

The case of the above named ship received the consideration of the Committee on Friday the 11th instant in connection with the overdue Special and Boiler Surveys.

The Special Survey became due in March, 1960, and a partial General Examination was held afloat at Malmo in June. To complete that inspection the vessel requires to be seen in drydock and the fore and after peak tanks examined internally, together with a General Examination of the machinery. After sundry postponements the Owners were informed that the completion of the inspection must be taken in hand by the end of September, 1960, and as that arrangement was not fulfilled, the Committee suspended the class on the 11th instant.

A cablegram has since been received from the Piraeus Surveyors stating they have been informed the ship would be available for survey at your port at the beginning of this present month.

In the circumstances the Committee have decided to await developments and if you are asked to complete the General Examination and to hold a Main Boiler Survey it will be quite in order for you so to do; the class will be reinstated on receipt of satisfactory reports on these lines provided these inspections are held at an early date.
