Steamer "DANAE"

With reference to the Special Survey which became due at the end of March last, I have to acquaint you that the Malmo Surveyors reported, at the beginning of June, that a General Examination for postponement of this inspection had been commenced afloat and that to complete the survey the ship required to be examined in drydock and the fore and after peak tanks to be examined internally.

The case was considered by the Committee at that time and, bearing in mind the age of the ship, they deferred action on the understanding that the General Examination would be completed by the end of July.

In reply to cabled enquiry the Piraeus Surveyors stated recently that the Owners are arranging to drydock the ship at Suez before the end of this month and to deal with the overdue Main Boiler Survey at that time.

The case has, therefore, been reported to the Committee again and they have agreed to this arrangement on the definite understanding that the required inspections will be carried out without fail as now proposed.

At the same time the Piraeus Surveyors have drawn attention to the fees already outstanding in this case, and I send, for your information, a copy of a letter, dated the 6th September, which has been sent to Piraeus and would draw your attention to the decision that the outstanding fees must be settled before you undertake your survey and that any Interim Certificates to be issued by you can only be handed over on receipt of the fees and expenses for your survey.
