With reference to your classing letter of the 14th instant, I beg to state that the thicknesses of the shell plating as reported are representative of those obtained by drilling on the port and starboard sides of the ship, so that in my opinion the notation s.s.Ams. 11-46 (Dr.) may be assigned.

The item in the General Remarks of the 1st entry report regarding the drilling of several parts of the vessel should read ".... found as tabulated in this report", in stead of ".... in accordance with the submitted plans", for which omission I beg to be excused.
