ALTERATIONS:-

Port Side:- 4 cowl ventilators (2 - 8" dia., 2 - 6" dia.) and one
gooseneck type ventilator (6" dia.) on upper deck leading to D.E.M.S.
accommodation in after 'tween deck and seven side scuttles in way
removed and apertures permanently closed with welded spigot plates.

Starboard Side:- 2 cowl ventilators (6" dia.) and one gooseneck type
ventilator (6" dia.) on upper deck leading to D.E.M.S. accommodation
in after 'tween deck, three side scuttles and two storm valves in way
removed and apertures permanently closed with welded spigot plates.

Hose tested on completion and found satisfactory.
