It will be noted from the Boiler FIRST ENTRY Report that the Boilers for this Vessel were built by Messrs. Canadian Vickers Limited, under the supervision of the British Corporation Surveyors. These three (3) Boilers replace three (3) Boilers made by Dominion Bridge Company Limited under the supervision of this Society's Surveyors, and installed in the S. S. "FORT ABITIBI".

It was agreed with the British Corporation Surveyors in Montreal and ourselves that our Societies would charge the full Survey Fees for the Vessels concerned, and thus avoid cross-charging each other. We trust that this action will be found in order.
