

and that her Machinery Classification Record be continued in the Book, without fresh record of survey, subject to the fire extinguishing line being placed in good condition, the emergency fire pump being placed in good condition, the lagging on the boilers being satisfactory restored, the generators to be cleaned as necessary, the ammeters of the outer generator to be overhauled and the earth faults on the outgoing cables from the switchboard being dealt with, the lighting in the E.R. and B.R. to be permanently restored and all temporary lighting to be removed or made permanent at Rotterdam to which port the ship is now proceeding direct from Bremen


