We would refer to our Report No. 19796, forwarded on the 31st December last, on which we do not as yet appear to have received a classing letter.

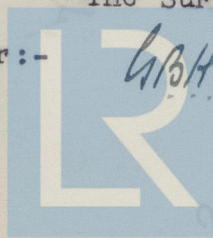
