Dear Sir,

I beg to inform you that the motortanker "BRISSAC" of Dunkirk has been sold to Messrs. North Atlantic Marine Co. Inc., New York.

Ship has been in floating dock at Haugesund and we were called in for examination of screwshaft only as it was stated the class would be transferred to American Bureau.

Ship is now at Lervik, Stord where it is stated she is to be converted for the carriage of iron ore under the supervision of American Bureau.

It has been stated here that an A.B. Surveyor has to come to Lervik from the United Kingdom as they have only a non-exclusive Surveyor at Bergen and it therefore occurs to me that the owners may decide to continue the L.R. class if our New York Surveyors could see them and inform them that 3 L.R. Surveyors are stationed at Bergen, near Lervik, and that they thereby will have better service.
