H. I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant relative to the steamer "EMIL R. BOMAN" the contents of which have been noted, and in reply I have to say that the 3rd Special Survey No.1 of this vessel has been commenced by the examination of the bottom and rudder, and the sea connections and fastenings and the verification of the freeboard.

I may remind you that the upper gudgeon of the stern frame, which has been repaired by electric welding, requires to be specially examined at the next drydocking.
