Dear Sirs,

With reference to the survey which became due last March on the boilers of the steamer "EMIL R. BOMAN" I have to acquaint you that the Owners have informed the Society's Surveyors at Stockholm that this inspection will be carried out on the vessel's arrival at Amsterdam in about ten days' time.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention in due course.

I may add for your information that the 3rd Special Survey No.1 has been commenced by the examination of the bottom and rudder, sea connections and fastenings and the verification of the freeboard, and a proposal to complete this inspection within the year of grace has been agreed to by the Committee.

I have also to inform you that the upper gudgeon of the stern frame, which has been repaired by electric welding, requires to be specially examined at the next drydocking
