With reference to my letter of the 14th instant relative to the 3rd Special Survey No.1 of the steamer "EMIL R. BOMAN", I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby report that the survey in question has been commenced by the examination of the bottom and rudder, and the sea connections and fastenings and the verification of the freeboard. The vessel has also been generally examined and the Committee have accordingly agreed to the completion of the Special Survey being postponed provided it be carried out within the year of grace, i.e. before the end of April, 1932.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly and ascertain and let me know what further arrangements have been made in regard to the Boiler Survey.
