The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement. — Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/6/92.)

This vessel is classed BS* (Whaling Purposes).

The SOUTH GEORGIA Surveyors report (10.49) the vessel placed on floating dock and, on account of damage cause not stated, shell plates in 'A' to 'D' strakes (p.s.) and 'B' to 'E' strakes (s.s.) found indented. The Surveyors do not make any recommendation regarding repairs. It is, however, considered that these should be dealt with as endorsements of class 'B'.

Minor repairs effected.

The requirements of an Annual Survey, due 10.49, have been complied with.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed by the British Corporation, with record of docking 6.49 and to have notation of "Annual Survey 10.49" assigned.
