*MBS (Saily) due 7.6.62 partly held 8.6.62, not advanced.*

Examined damage stated to have been sustained to inboard port furnace of the starboard main boiler, date and cause not stated.

Inboard port furnace of starboard main boiler now examined and found sagged up to 12" for full length of furnace and surveyor therefore recommends that the starboard main boiler not to be used until inboard furnace has been renewed.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible to remain as now classed subject as above and as now recommended.

Note

This vessel has been used as a storage ship since 1953 and has been removed from the Register except for the starboard boiler which has remained classed.

*To complete MBS(S) Subd Furnaces to be renewed. Safety Valves to be adjusted under steam and oil burning up to be examined.*
