The transversely framed tanker "LISS" at present stands in the Register Book with a qualifying notation of "Class suspended pending stiffening". We recently heard from the Bergen Surveyor that she was to be used as a storage ship in Stockholm and on the 8th ultimo we gave instructions for the Bremen Surveyors to issue a certificate to cover this voyage as desired provided they were satisfied with her condition after general examination afloat.

From another source we now hear that she has been sold to -

and that her port of registry will be Stockholm.
