



This vessel was examined in drydock in June 1953. In July 1953 a survey for damage on account of fire was carried out at Curacao and temporary repairs carried out subsequent to which the vessel proceeded to Bremen, where she has since been laid up.

In view of the above surveys, it is considered there is no objection to the Bremen Surveyors issuing a certificate of seaworthiness for the vessel to be towed to Stockholm provided they satisfy themselves by a general examination afloat that the vessel is in a suitable condition for the voyage.

SUBMITTED the Bremen Surveyors be wired as follows:-
