Transversely Framed Tanker "LISS"

Information has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Bergen that this vessel is proceeding to the yard of Messrs. A/G Weser at your port.

The deferred reports on the ship are enclosed for your information and guidance, and I shall be glad if you will arrange to carry out the detailed special inspection and drillings required by the Committee in this type of ship, and to report the results to this Office for consideration, while the ship is still under survey.

At the same time, I would draw special attention to the contents of my letter of the 9th instant addressed to the Owner in regard to the provisions of Circular 1994, and shall be glad if you will give this matter your special attention also.

It will be observed that further examination and repairs of port and centre boilers are required on the vessel's return to Europe, (see the latest report received, namely, Trinidad No.749).
