This is a transversely framed tanker - Category 3.

The class is subject to ship being specially examined in accordance with Circular letter dated 20.5.52 concerning transversely framed tankers.

Postponement of this special examination until early November 1953 approved 30.1.53 - refer Mr. Murray's memo dated 26.1.53.

The CURACAO Surveyors report (7,53), this tanker examined afloat and on account of fire, deck and bulkhead plating and structure in way of stokehold (p.s.) extensively damaged, temporary repairs effected and permanent repairs recommended by 10,53.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED for repairs, subject as above.
