QUESTION.

ANSWER.

With reference to the entry in the Special Reasons List, I shall be glad to learn what arrangements the owners propose making for 15 fathoms of chain cable to be supplied and recommended by the Gothenburg Surveyors in November last.

I think it well to add that the Special Survey No. 1 has been completed in this case, but that the completion of a notation of this inspection has been deferred pending further examination of the bottom in way of No.2 cargo tank and renewal of shell plates B 5 (port and starboard) at the next drydocking.

You will observe that the next Survey will become due at the end of next month.

Date:— Oslo 1st June 1939.

The owners state that 15th Fathoms chain cable have been purchased and stored in the U.K. to be fitted on board at the first given opportunity, at any rate during the docking in August/September next.

As regards the Boiler Survey the owners request to have this survey postponed until the docking in August/September next and we shall be glad to be informed whether the owners' request may be agreed to.
