The class of this ship was withdrawn at the request of the previous Owners and the Notation - "Class withdrawn 4,64" entered in the Register Book.

Prior to disclassing there was an S.R.L.  
Appendix Note - Poop side plating etc. (p.s) indented.

In a London letter dated 22.5.64 to the Falmouth Surveyors it was stated the ship was to be transferred to the Greek Flag and the new Owners required the Society to issue a Load Line Certificate for a voyage from the U.K. to Greece.

It was agreed that the Society would issue the desired Load Line Certificate provided the Society's Surveyors were able to hold a General Examination of the ship's structure in dry dock and to hold a Load Line Survey. The Falmouth Surveyors were requested on completion of the survey to issue a Certificate LLST (after altering the lettering on grid to Greek characters) and advised the LLST should be endorsed "and only whilst engaged on a voyage from the U.K. to Greece" made valid for a suitable short period.

The FALMOUTH Surveyors in a Rpt.8 No.14592 report (5,64), the ship placed in dry dock, a General Examination held in accordance with Circular No.1959 and found in satisfactory condition and a Certificate LLST issued.

In view of the above the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
