With reference to the telephone conversation with the Plymouth Office today, the gist of which will no doubt have been passed to you, the above ship which is in Willoughby's Drydock at Plymouth ~~this summer~~ is to be transferred to the Greek Flag and the new Owners require the Society to issue a Loadline Certificate for a voyage from the United Kingdom to Greece.

The vessel's class has been withdrawn, but it has been agreed that the Society will issue the desired Loadline Certificate, provided the Society's Surveyors are able to hold a General Examination of the ship's structure in drydock, and hold a Loadline Survey.

Please arrange accordingly and, on completion of your survey, issue a Certificate LLST (after altering the lettering on grid to Greek characters) with the existing freeboards which, in millimetres are:-

Tropical Fresh	191 millimetres
Fresh	299 "
Tropical	305 "
Summer	413 "
Winter	521 "
Winter North Atlantic	591 "
