I duly received your letter of the 19th May regarding maintenance of this ship in class and in reply I am to say that provided the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys are carried out now, and the ship is submitted to a General Examination of the hull and machinery, and a satisfactory report is received from the Society's Surveyors, the Committee will be agreeable to the class being reinstated and the Special Survey being deferred until the end of February 1965.

The vessel's present Load Line certificate will expire on the 31st January 1965 but will be extended for a period of one month on completion of a satisfactory renewal survey nearer the expiry date.
