"MYKINAI" ex "EDDYBEACH"

I have learned from Messrs. Willoughby (Plymouth) Ltd. that the above vessel is to be drydocked here on Friday, 22nd May prior to making a voyage to Greece.

It is understood that the Owners intend to sail the vessel to Greece under her own power, possibly with part cargo, and towing the S.T. "EDDYCLIFF" which has been purchased by the same Owners.

No request has been made by the Owners for survey, but as a request may be received within the next few days it is thought well to verify the survey requirements in view of the length of time the vessel has been laid up. It is understood that the "EDDYCLIFF" will not be drydocked and will be towed as a dead ship.
